- *Competition Section 2* - "Spot gender identity" - projection of the videos made by the schools
- *Competition Section 3* - "Photography" - projection of the slide show "Photos on gender"

The morning will be concluded with a musical performance by the *Orchestra Multiethnica Mediterranea*.
